Tournament Schedule

At this point the tournament schedule will be the same as announced in Bulletin #1. The final schedule may deviate slightly based on the decisions by the Chief Judge and any changes will be posted.

Site Familiarization/Practice

Please note that all lakes will be closed effective Monday, September 3, 2012. The only use on the lakes will be for students at the Pickos Ski School. Site homologation will be conducted on September 7 and possibly on the 8th depending on the Chief Judge and Homologator.

Reservations may be made on an hourly basis for **Saturday, September 8 through Monday, September 10 from 7:00AM until 6:00PM. Reservations may be made for Tuesday, September 11 from 7:00AM until 3:00PM.**

Site familiarization will be available for all teams at the rate of **\$250 per hour** (includes 55 minutes on the water and 5 minutes for refueling)

To secure a reservation, **all fees must be paid in advance** no later than August 15. If site familiarization fees are not paid by that time the reserved time may be awarded to another team or individual.

Familiarization may be reserved for either lake (Lake Adam Slalom/Trick/Jump and Lake Alexis Slalom/Trick). Note that during the tournament all Slalom will be on Lake Alexis and all Trick/Jump will be on Lake Adam.

Reservations are on a first come basis, so it is important to get your time slot reserved as early as possible.

In fairness to all teams, site familiarization will be available and distributed equally to all countries in accordance with the following policy:

Initially, each country will have 60 minutes available to them on each lake Saturday, Sunday and Monday and 30 minutes available to them on Tuesday on each lake.

After June 30, 2012, if a team has not registered for its allotted time the remaining time periods will be awarded to anyone who desires to register for more time.

NOTE: Each team MUST register for its respective familiarization time or their time may be awarded to another team after the deadline. Please make your intentions known as early as possible.

Individual practice sets may be held at the conclusion of competition each day time permitting. Individual practice must be arranged directly with Cory Pickos on each day. We cannot schedule individual practice in advance since times or availability on each lake cannot be ascertained in advance. Individual sets are \$25 (4 jumps, 4 slalom passes, or 10 minutes of tricks) and can be paid at time of practice.
